Theoretical work in general, and mathematical models in particular, provided the basis for a mutual discussion and, thus, helped to overcome difficulties in understanding the results of different experimental fields. Chemical systems, for example, are more rigorously controllable through their experimental conditions in comparison to biological systems, which maintain highly effective autonomous control against environmental influences. Therefore, different states such as bistability, oscillations and chaos can be defined and, hence, described better in chemical systems. Chemical systems may thus provide some insights into functional structures that also exist in more complex biological systems.
